

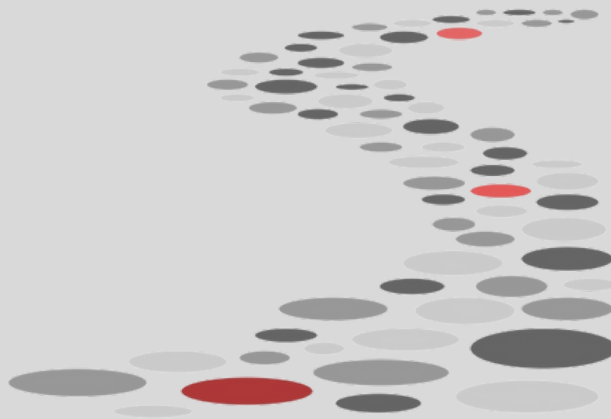

OUR SERVICES

EMPLOYMENT SERVICES

Employment Services assists people with disabilities with their employment needs. Our goal is to provide support to our job seekers in finding a job in their community. We do this through providing quality services that will help the job seeker build skills, discover their interests and find their dream job.

These services include, but are not limited to:

VOCATIONAL SERVICES

When you are involved in our Vocational Services program, you will have the opportunity to enhance your job skills through work based activities and our production contracts.

In house production is often paid at a piece rate and includes:

- Light Assembly
- Quality Sorts/Inspection
- Packaging
- Clerical and Collating

Marimor Industries, Inc. also provides confidential document destruction and partners with businesses in the community for enclaves, or on site work crews. Individuals involved in these areas earn an hourly rate of pay no less than minimum wage.

HABILITATION SERVICES

Our Day Services program is based around activities centered on individualized interests. When you participate in our Habilitation program you can expect to be active in:

- Community volunteering
- Work skills growth
- Peer mentoring and leadership
- Community outings and events
- Crafts, games and clubs
- Social and interpersonal communication development
- Daily living and educational programs



HOME/PERSONAL CARE (HPC)

HPC supports a person to be more independent while meeting their daily living needs and advances the individual's independence within his/her home and community.



TRANSPORTATION

In order to ensure all individuals have access to services, we provide transportation to and from locations. For your safety and comfort we have a fleet of 14 vans; six of which are wheelchair vans. To ensure that you arrive on time to work, we have six to eight routes running from 6 a.m. - 11 p.m., M-Sat. Marimor Industries also has five minibusses and two buses to transport individuals to and from the Industries.
